EL CAPULÍN

The annual Monarch butterfly migration is one of nature's great spectacles and a top attraction for visitors to Mexico's central highlands. Monarch butterflies travel over 2500 miles from eastern Canada to centras Mexico. A beautiful tourist destination that offers one of the Monarch Butterfly Biosphere Reserves, El Capullín was declared a Worl Heritage Site by UNESCO in 2008.

1.5 hours drive from the centre of Valle de Bravo, visitors can leave their car in the parking lot and hike for about 4km through beautiful landscapes adroned with confierous trees packed with Monarch butterflies.
