



Haute Route Rider's Sustainability Charter

Protecting the environment is crucial for the future of our society. Cycling is a sport close to nature, so we must respect and preserve the environment for future generations. With this in mind, the Haute Route organisers invite you to join them by signing our Rider's Sustainability Charter to act for the sustainable development of our sport.

By participating in the Haute Route, I pledge to:

1. Respect the values of sport and cycling, in particular "fair play", mutual support between riders and friendliness.
2. Protect the environment and natural areas passed through by staying on the official course and not throwing litter on the ground.
3. Always use my jersey pockets to store my rubbish whilst I ride, and dispose of it at designated points at refreshment points.
4. Reduce the amount of rubbish that I generate and use bins provided in the Race Village and at refreshment points.
5. Sort waste into the designated bins for recycling.
6. Behave in an ethical manner towards all vehicles, other participants and the organization, especially when passing through cities and villages visited by the event.
7. Respect the local organising team in each host venue and the hundreds of volunteers who will ensure your safety along the course.
8. Educate those around me about sustainability and promote cycling as a modern and eco-friendly mode of transport.

I am fully aware that if I drop any litter on the course - even once - I will not be classified for that stage and will not be considered an official Finisher of the Haute Route. The Team "Sud Vélo NE JETEZ PLUS" are riding with you to remind you: Do not litter!
